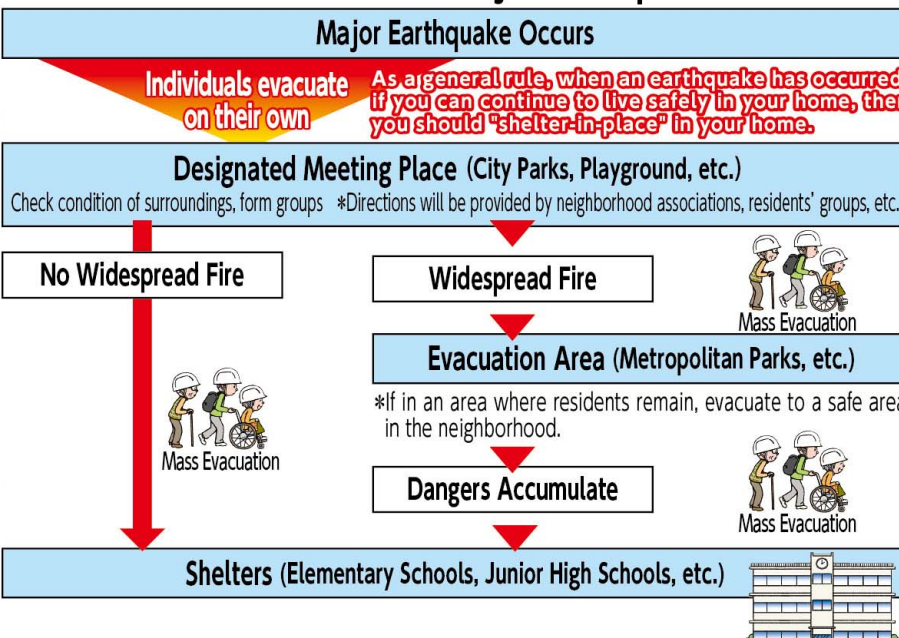

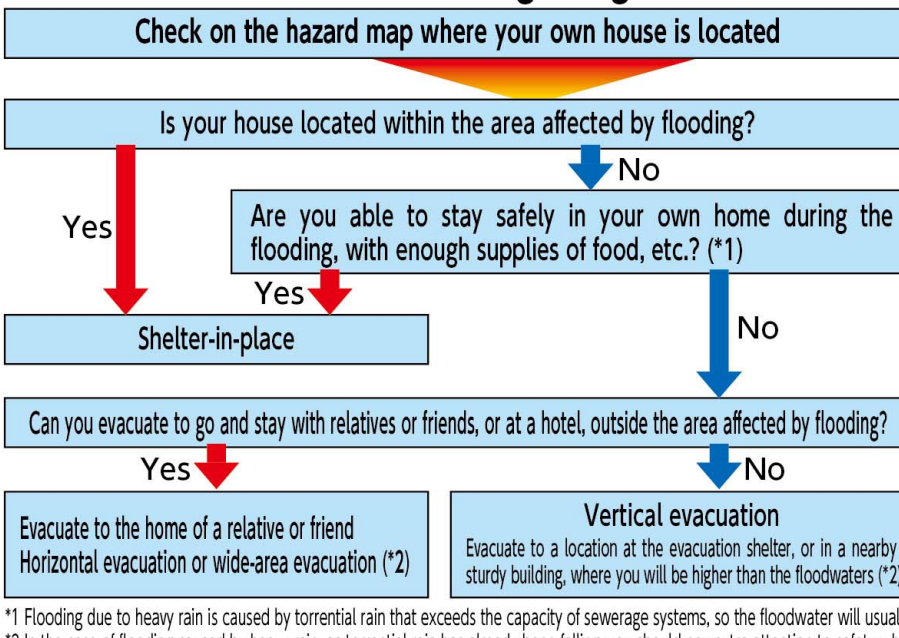
Evacuation

Stages in an Evacuation

In the event of a major earthquake



In the event of flooding or high tides



*1 Flooding due to heavy rain is caused by torrential rain that exceeds the capacity of sewerage systems, so the floodwater will usually subside relatively quickly.
*2 In the case of flooding caused by heavy rain, as torrential rain has already been falling, you should pay extra attention to safety when evacuating.

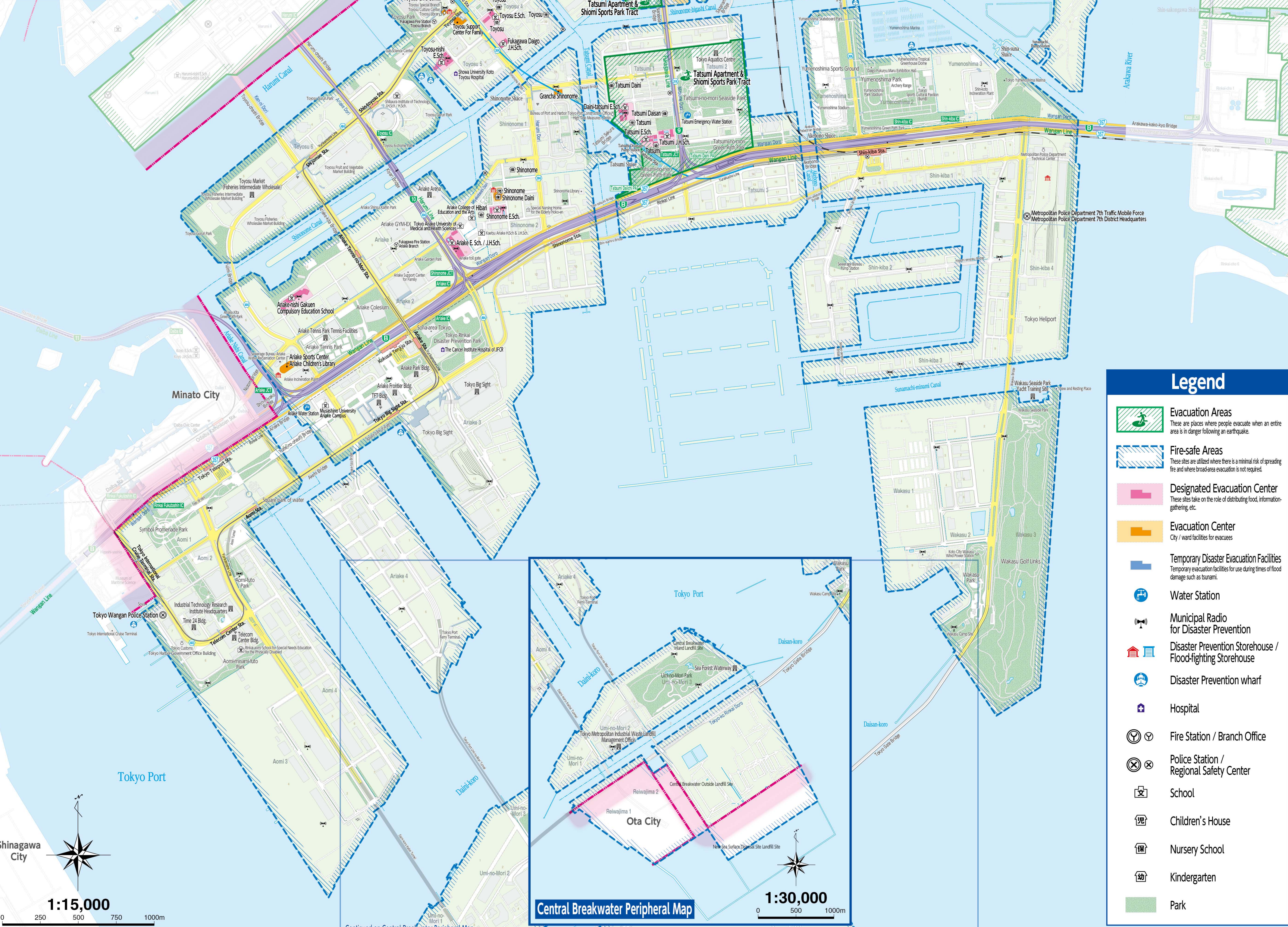

List of Metropolitan Temporary Residence Facilities in Koto City

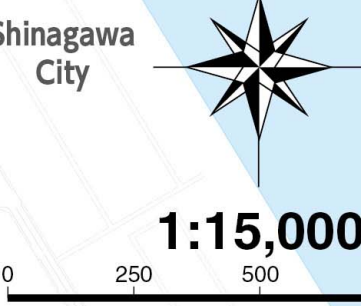
Temporary residence facilities are sites that can temporarily accept stranded persons who do not have a place to wait until it becomes possible for them to return to their homes. Those facilities that are operated by the Tokyo metropolitan government or that make use of facilities owned by entities connected to the government together comprise metropolitan temporary residence facilities.

Legend

- Evacuation Areas
These are places where people evacuate when an entire area is in danger following an earthquake.
- Fire-safe Areas
These sites are utilized where there is a minimal risk of spreading fire and where broad-area evacuation is not required.
- Designated Evacuation Center
These sites take on the role of distributing food, information, gathering, etc.
- Evacuation Center
City / ward facilities for evacuees
- Temporary Disaster Evacuation Facilities
Temporary evacuation facilities for use during times of flood damage such as tsunami.
- Water Station
- Municipal Radio for Disaster Prevention
- Disaster Prevention Storehouse / Flood-fighting Storehouse
- Disaster Prevention wharf
- Hospital
- Fire Station / Branch Office
- Police Station / Regional Safety Center
- School
- Children's House
- Nursery School
- Kindergarten
